

IMAM CONGRESS

The International Maritime Association of the Mediterranean (IMAM) is a voluntary organization that was initially established in 1974 by institutions from six countries (Bulgaria, Egypt, Greece, Italy, Yugoslavia and Turkey), and was progressively enlarged to other countries neighboring the Mediterranean.

The IMAM congress, organized by this Association is one of the major congresses on maritime transport and technologies. The Congress has more than forty-year history since the first one held in Istanbul in 1978. The last successful congress was held in Varna, Bulgaria in 2019, and the next one was planned to be held in Istanbul, Turkey in 2021. However, this congress is postponed to September 26-29, 2022 due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

IMAM 2022 CONGRESS

The 19th International Congress of International Maritime Association of the Mediterranean, IMAM 2022 will be delivered in-person in Istanbul, Turkey and virtually, providing the opportunity of on-line presentation for the people who can not attend the congress in-person for any reason.
